To further our mission, we established the ORPIB Foundation, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit focused on providing mentorship, training, and direct support for LGBTQ+ entrepreneurs—especially in rural and underserved areas. Together, ORPIB and the ORPIB Foundation create pathways for success and inclusion.

As we prepare for 2025-2026, we have ambitious plans to fortify and expand our programs, strengthen partnerships, and deepen our impact.

- 2024 Hired first Executive Director & created Expansion Advisory Board


Our Staff


Our Volunteers

Thrive in Business Virtual Learning Series

In 2024, ORPIB proudly hosted 20 dynamic virtual learning sessions led by 13 volunteer expert professionals. These sessions covered essential business topics, including Digital Marketing, Business Legal Fundamentals, Financial Tools for Business Preservation, Inclusive Policy Writing, and Human Resources.

This program delivers value on multiple levels:

- Showcase Expertise: Members have the opportunity to present in their areas of expertise, enhancing visibility and generating business leads.
- Accessible Learning: Members gain free access to all live sessions and an on-demand digital archive, ensuring continuous learning and professional development.

Through this initiative, ORPIB empowers businesses with critical knowledge while fostering a community of shared expertise and growth.

Mentorship

Modeled after the National LGBT Chamber of Commerce (NGLCC) mentorship initiative, ORPIB's Mentorship Program goes a step further by being open to the entire community—not just ORPIB members. This inclusive approach reflects our commitment to fostering entrepreneurial growth and community connection.

Program Highlights:

- Personalized Mentorship: Mentees are paired 1:1 with experienced mentors who provide personalized guidance and support over a 12-month period.
- Complimentary Membership: Mentees receive a free ORPIB Membership during their program, giving them full access to member benefits and networking opportunities.
- Regular Check-Ins: Monthly mentor check-ins ensure mentees stay on track toward their business goals.
- Community-Building Events: Quarterly gatherings connect all program participants, fostering a supportive, growth-oriented community.
- **Supplemental Learning:** Thrive in Business Learning Series content is included as an additional resource for program participants.


